By-law No. 780/07

## Being a by-law to regulate traffic in Haldimand County

**WHEREAS** Section 137 of the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u>, R.S.O 1990, c.H8, as amended, authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws to provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County did on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2006 enact By-law No. 709/06 in accordance with Section 137 of the *Highway Traffic Act* so as to provide for an all-way stop condition at the intersection of McKenzie Road and 4<sup>th</sup> Line for the duration of the designated detour resulting from the native occupation in Caledonia;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County now deems it expedient to remove the existing all-way stop condition and to provide for a reinstatement of a two-way stop condition at the aforementioned intersection;

## NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** By-law No. 709/06 be hereforth repealed.
- 2. **THAT** a two-way stop condition be established as follows:

Direction of Traffic	Street	Intersection at
North-west / South-east	4 <sup>th</sup> Line Oneida	McKenzie Road

- 3. **THAT** every person operating a vehicle shall comply with any traffic control device erected in compliance with this by-law.
- 4. **THAT** every person contravening any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is subject to a fine recoverable under the <u>Provincial Offences Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.33, as amended.
- 5. **THAT** any provision of any by-law of The Corporation of Haldimand County in consistent with this by-law is hereby repealed.
- 6. **AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect thirty (30) days from the date of passing.

READ a first and second time this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of January, 2007.

READ a third time and finally passed this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of January, 2007.
