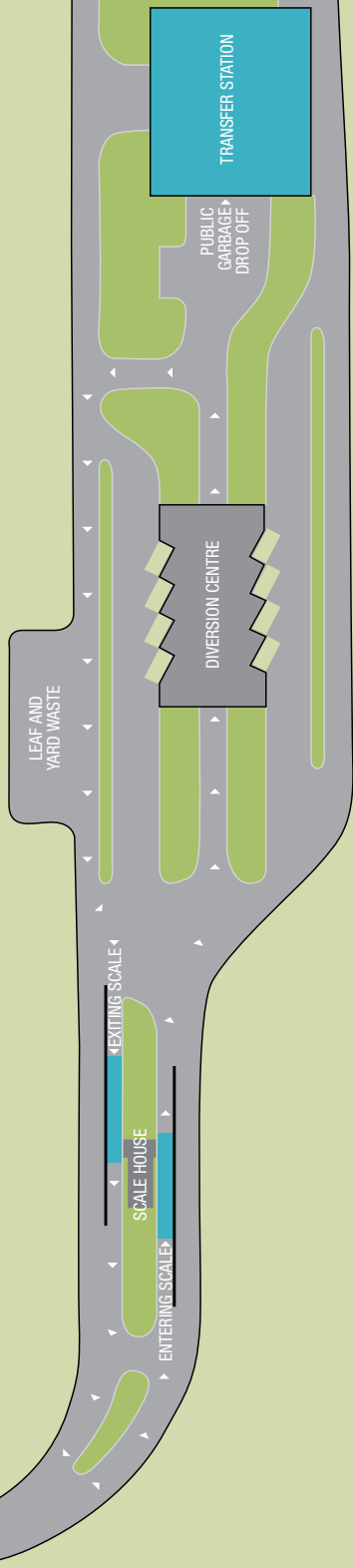

# CANBOROUGH WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY

A new Diversion Centre has been constructed in order to reduce the amount of waste sent for landfill.

*October 31, 2015 marks the closure of the Tom Howe Landfill Site located just outside of Hagersville.*

Post closure, Haldimand County will be directing all waste generated within the County to the Canborough Transfer Station where the waste will be transferred to an alternative landfill, located southwest of London. This is one of the main drivers for our efforts in increasing waste diversion - we will be reducing the amount of truckloads of waste sent down the road which will also reduce greenhouse gas emissions and save landfill space.



*There are some operational changes that you should be prepared for before bringing your material to the new site.*

Before you proceed to the garbage drop-off you will be required to sort your waste into the various bins located at the diversion centre. Some of the new divertible materials include:

- **CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION MATERIAL** – these materials will be recovered and recycled for future use. Examples of this material include: drywall, insulation, clean and unclean wood, concrete, asphalt, and any other material generated from a construction/demolition project.
- **SHINGLES** – they will be recycled and used for addition to asphalt.
- **CARDBOARD** – since this material is already recycled through the curbside blue box program, the bin at the Diversion Centre is for larger loads that are too big for our curbside trucks.
- **BULKY RIGID PLASTICS** – these are materials which are not included in your blue box program. Some examples include: all sizes of plastic buckets and pails; plastic crates and trays; laundry baskets; old blue & black boxes; plastic garbage cans; plastic lawn furniture; pet carriers; plastic toys, playhouses, totes and tool cases; and more!
- **LEAF AND YARD WASTE** – this will be made into saleable compost. Accepted seasonally free of charge.
- **METAL, TIRES, ELECTRONICS & TEXTILES** – we have offered these programs for a number of years now. For more information on acceptable electronics please refer to your Residential Waste & Recycling Guide.
- **ALL OTHER RECYCLABLES** – there are recycling totes located at our Diversion Centre for you to recycle any other recyclable material accepted in the curbside blue box program.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All customers are to report to the Scalehouse upon arrival.
- Please secure all open loads with a tarp or rope.
- Customers are expected to sort their loads by material type.
- Please pre-sort loads prior to delivery for quick and easy unloading.
- Remove all fluids (gas, oil, etc.) from gas powered equipment such as lawnmowers.
- Oil drums and tanks must be empty and cut in half.
- Residential hazardous fluids may be dropped off free of charge at the Household Hazardous Waste Event Days, see website or your Residential Waste and Recycling Guide for details.
