Subsequent to the completion of CS-FI-M01-2016, staff's preparation of the related by-law revealed that the Jarvis 2 Drain Maintenance cannot be billed at this time. An engineer will be required to prepare a revised assessment schedule for the maintenance of this drain which will then be billed in 2017.
