5. Business Arising

5.1 Heritage Designation: The Merchant House

Bob and Cherilyn Gibson are in the process of obtaining quotes from various fabricators including Fontasy (Uxbridge) and Sticker-It (Dunnville); preliminary findings note the signage may be in the range of \$900 - \$1,200.

5.2 Cottonwood Mansion, Selkirk

Review of the designation and discussion related to Items for Designation (exterior) and whether "entablature details" included the porch/pillars. The Liaison was asked to provide details from previous Heritage Haldimand meetings (2014/15) where the Committee had dealt with issues related to the pillars.

The Committee will review this information at the March 25th meeting in order to provide a response to Cottonwood.

5.3 Dunnville Storyboards and Dollier & Galinée Plaque

Partnership with the Dunnville District Heritage Association (DDHA) and Heritage Haldimand (Haldimand County Beautification Grant). Sylvia Weaver reported that while the Jackman Foundation has offered to donate funds to both projects additional fundraising will need to take place to complete the project in its entirety.

5.4 St. John's Church, York

This property has been placed on the market. The Liaison has fielded several calls from individuals enquiring as to the history of the building and site.

5.5 Outreach/Workshops for 2021

Angela Wallace attended the "Old House Symposium" (Edifice Atelier Institute) and found the information presented an excellent overview for historic home owners. Staff are working to compile an updated listing of heritage property owners in order to share details on courses such as window restoration, general repair and maintenance, etc.
