Hello,

I am pleased to announce that the Enteric Outbreak and COVID-19 Watch are declared over.

All surveillance swabs obtained for COVID-19 testing are negative.

I want to thank the Residents for their cooperation with co-horting, families and visitors for adhering to the visiting restrictions and Grandview Lodge staff for their ongoing commitment to the care, safety and wellbeing of our Residents.

Visitation to the home has resumed back to pre-outbreak measures. As a reminder visitors are required to show proof of full vaccination, anyone who has not provided proof of full vaccination must complete a rapid antigen test prior to visiting their loved one in the home. Anyone with new or worsening symptoms associated with COVID-19 or who fails the screening procedure at the point of entry will not be permitted to enter the home.

Please ensure you practice frequent hand hygiene during all visits to the home and when out in public as this is a proven preventative strategy in the transmission of bacterial and viral pathogens. Vaccines are a safe and effective way of mitigating health risks associated with Influenza and COVID-19. Speak to your physician or visit your local pharmacy today to get your shot.
