By-law Number 2327/22

Being a by-law to regulate traffic in Haldimand County – All-Way Stop Condition, Caledonia

WHEREAS Section 137 (a) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990., c.H.8, as amended, authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws providing for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County deems it expedient to install an all way stop condition at a certain intersection in Caledonia,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of Haldimand County enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** an All Way Stop condition be established as follows:

Traffic Direction	Intersection (At)
All Way	Orkney Street East at Nairne Street

- 2. **THAT** every person operating a vehicle shall comply with any traffic control device erected in compliance with this by-law.
- 3. **THAT** this by-law shall take precedence over any other by-law with which it is inconsistent.
- **4. AND THAT** this by-law shall come into force and take effect when signage applicable to this provision has been installed and is on display.

READ a first and second time this 13th day of January, 2022.

READ a third time and finally passed this 13th day of January, 2022.
